Achieva offers options to help people with disabilities achieve their employment and community participation goals.

- **Career Assessment** is a person-centered, individualized employment assessment used to assist in the identification of potential career options, including self-employment, based upon the interests and strengths of the participant.
- **Job Coaching and Support** assists each worker with a disability reach job-related performance standards of the employer. Job Coaching and Support can provide worksite orientation, coordination of accommodations, maintenance of appropriate work, interpersonal behavior on the job, and other supports for the successful employment of the individual and workplace needs of the employer.
- **Job Finding and Development** includes employer outreach and orientation, job searching, job development, resume preparation and interview assistance and may include customized job development.
- **Community Participation** engages participants in a variety of activities through volunteerism, recreation and other opportunities to develop the foundation needed to transition into employment opportunities.
