Our Services

Achieva Family Trust: Planning for the future and enhancing lives through special needs trusts and social service supports.

Advocacy & Family Supports: Aiding in the navigation of educational, medical, government and adult service systems.

Business Operations: Providing employment opportunities to people with disabilities while producing high quality products and services.

Business Services: Providing on-site, expert consultation to private-sector businesses to assist them with recruiting, hiring, on-boarding, and retaining talent with disabilities.

Competitive-Integrated Employment: Matching a job seekers' skills and interests to real jobs in the community.

Community Living: Licensed homes providing comfort in a community setting.

Community Participation Supports: Engaging in new and interesting activities in the community to experience all that society has to offer.

Disability Healthcare Initiative (DHI): Offering state-wide leadership on improving access to health care for people with disabilities.

Early Intervention: Providing a *Strong Start* to children ages birth – three by our well-trained therapists.

“A Home of My Own”: Provides the supports for people to live safely in a home they choose.

Home Care: Provides in-home and community support.

Housing Tenancy: Offering resources to locate and maintain cost-effective, accessible housing.

Lifesharing: Family living arrangement in the home of an unrelated, supportive family.

Older Adult Protective Services: Protecting people 60 years of age and older. *Through a contract with the Beaver County Office on Aging.*

Parenting Support: Parenting education for parents and caregivers who have disabilities.

Recreation: Serving opportunities for fun and learning in a safe environment outside of the home.

Representative Payee: Granting peace of mind through a secure approach to money management.

Supported Living: Services in one's own home, designed to meet individual needs and goals.
